

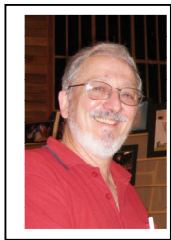

Hello Everyone,

This is an informational column this month. At the recent committee meeting we reviewed how the club was responding to our massive membership of 110 members. We have responded to the pressures that growth has placed upon the club, and I have listed some of our initiatives here.

Our major changes are to the General Secretarial functions and workload. We have split-out the Website/Forum, Membership Secretary and Handbooks (digital format) functions from the General Secretaries workload. This should give us a better response to membership changes and minimize the workload peaks which occur at the start of each New Year and during the Redlands, National, and Schools Competitions during the year.

Speaking of competitions, our 13th Annual Redlands Competition is coming up. We have three major working bees where we will be calling on you for assistance. Saturday 8th - Print and Projected Images sorting. This is an interesting day where you will be able to have a sneak peek at entries whilst they are being sorted into their sections. The day starts at 8.30am and finishes in mid afternoon.

Judging 15th May. This is your opportunity to see how impact judging works. We anticipate about 1000 entries all up for the prints and projected images. It is a busy day.

Re-sorting 12th June. This is where all entries are placed back into their original packaging and readied for postage back to competitors.

So, when the clip-board comes around at our meetings, please consider if you can assist. We will provide time slots during these days for you to offer your assistance. We offer "on the job" training for any members who have not participated in previous working bees. These are great opportunities for you to meet fellow members and see how your club works as a team. Many hands can lighten the workload.

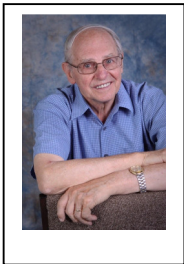
Our Whepstead Manor Portrait afternoon is looking great. (17th April 2.30pm). We will have ten models in national costume available. Be there!

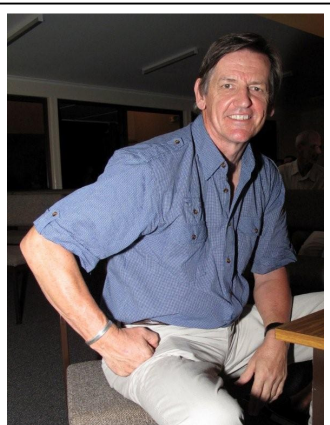

Redlands Exhibition of Photography

President Len has referred to the approach of the Redlands Exhibition and the need for volunteers to assist in its conduct. Our specific needs are:-

May 8th Preparation of the entries for judging. Our need is for up to four members to input entry details into the program. We also need several members to help open the packages, place identification labels on the reverse side of the prints and to sort the items into categories.

May 15th Judging day. We need a team of up to 12 members to assist. This will include at least one member to input the scores into the program, another to record the scores of the score sheets and another to do so on the print. There are also several other jobs such as placing prints on and off the judging stand and controlling the accepted works.

May 27 Mounting of the prints on the print stands at Cleveland

June 12th A small group will be needed to repackage the entries and ready them for posting or picking up.
